## Unveiling of the LabCom "High-Throughput Catalysis center" by Seqens in partnership with the CNRS to develop innovative synthetic pathways and ultimately cut down generic drugs development times and costs

On June 8, 2021, in the presence of Seqens Scientific Committee, chaired by Pr Bernard Meunier, was inaugurated the "HitCat" LabCom, a joint research entity between the Seqens Group and the CNRS, hosted at the Seqens'Lab in Porcheville.

"HitCat" Labcom aims to create a center of excellence in multicatalysis, which consists in combining photocatalysis, biocatalysis and metal/organocatalysis to foster reaction discovery and optimization. The Labcom will deploy a High-throughput testing platform to allow faster experimentation.

The Labcom scientific program will be led by Dr Geraldine Masson and Dr Gérard Guillamot for the Seqens Scientific Direction.

Géraldine Masson is a Research Director at the Institute of Chemistry of Natural Substances (ICSN), with world-class expertise in catalysis. She has received numerous awards, including CNRS Bronze Medal (2013), SEQENS Prize of the Sciences Academy Awards (2017) and J-M Lehn Prize from the Organic Chemistry Division of the French Chemical Society (2019). She has been an associate editor for The Journal of Organic Chemistry since 2019.
